

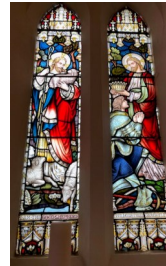
pain, and may they feel comfort in the offering of love, warmth and support, and the peace that passes all understanding, in Jesus' name. Amen.
